Respect Life Corner
Each year on January 22, all dioceses in the United States are called to observe a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. January 22 is the anniversary of the 1973 Supreme Court decisions that legalized abortion throughout our nation. Since then, over 60 million lives have been lost. On June 24, 2022, the Dobbs v. Jackson Women’s Health Organization decision overturned Roe v. Wade. While God, in His mercy, ended the nearly fifty-year abortion on demand, state and federal laws, in many instances, are still hostile to the unborn.

“When I was 6 years old, I told my mom I could never be a nun – I’d get too hot in a habit, I said, and faint. The Lord led me to religious life through experiences of serving the poor with my family. My dad, an optometrist, organized annual eye care missions in underserved countries.
