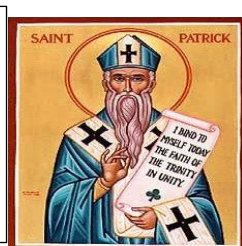

United States in June of 1948 and laid to rest on June 5, 1948, in St. Patrick-Tipton Cemetery.
