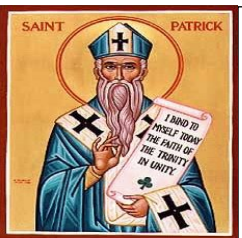

CCHD Collection Weekend of November 21/22. This week we welcome Sam and Marie Franklin as they speak on the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD). Forty million people in the United States live in poverty, including many in our diocese. This collection supports programs that empower people to identify and address the obstacles they face as they work to bring positive change to their communities. 25% of the collection stays in our diocese to fund local community and economic development projects in economically challenged areas. Schools and PSRs in our diocese received grants totaling \$3,096 for Catholic Social Teaching and poverty education. The remaining amount goes to the CCHD national office to fund large grants throughout the nation. This past year, over \$135,000 in national funding was given to groups in our Diocese to create long lasting economic and community improvements.
