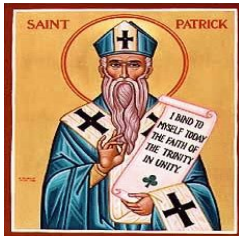

Respect Life Corner- *Open my eyes, Lord. Help me to see as you see!* In the Gospel of John, society assumed that the man was blind because he was a sinner. When Jesus healed him on the Sabbath, the Pharisees also thought Jesus was a sinner as He broke the Law of Moses.. Jesus saw something different in the blind man; not a sinner, but a man in need of healing and redemption. The blind man, in turn, saw Jesus, not as a sinner who broke the law, but as the Messiah who frees us from sin and restores us back to right relationship with our Father. He was so moved that he worshipped him. How does this gospel relate to us and our view of others? Do we see our fellow brothers and sisters as sinners, or companions on a journey also in need of God's saving grace?
Learn, Act, Connect and Pray- Let's work together this week to withhold judgement and to show kindness instead of mercy to others; the same kindness and mercy that we would like shown to us. Ask God to heal our view of the world and to see the world as He does, through His eyes!

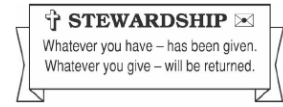
