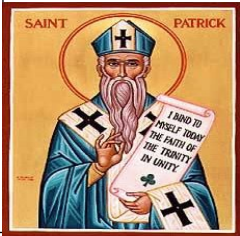

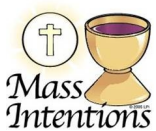

Respect Life Corner: “Now I know brothers, that you acted out of ignorance, just as your leaders did.” In Acts of the Apostles, First Reading, Peter is talking to a large group of Jewish people who gathered after he cured a disabled man in Christ's name at the Beautiful Gate of the Temple of Jerusalem. In Solomon's Portico, Peter talks of how they denied God's Holy and Righteous One and put Him to death. In testifying to Christ's Resurrection, Peter calls his listeners (and us) to repent. When do we act, or don't act, out of ignorance to the needs of others, including families?
